THE POTENTIAL IMPACT OF BREXIT ON THE BANGLADESH READY-MADE GARMENTS (RMG) SECTOR

Mr. Md. Nazmul Quaunine took up his assignment as the High Commissioner of the People's Republic of Bangladesh to the United Kingdom on 28 October 2016. He had earlier served as the Ambassador of Bangladesh to Indonesia from February 2013 to October 2016 and was concurrently accredited as non-resident Ambassador to Timor-Leste and High Commissioner to the Papua New Guinea.

He was also the first concurrently accredited Ambassador of Bangladesh to the Association of the South East Asian Nations (ASEAN).

Sharifa Khan is Commercial Counsellor for the Bangladesh High Commission in London.

A Master in Economics with Honours from Dhaka University, and a Masters and Diploma in Development Economics from Australian National University, Sharifa has 26 years' work experience in government and international organisation.
